

Pre-School Aged Children
Questions & Answers

1. **Q Does True North Academy provide a pre-school program?**

A No. Our programming starts with Junior Kindergarten and all children registered for JK must be either age appropriate or be able to participate in our JK program. We are not a daycare.

2. **Q Do you accept children into the Junior Kindergarten program who do not turn 4 by the end of December?**

A Yes, but only if our program has vacancies available after accepting age appropriate children. Children who do not meet the age requirement will be put on a waiting list and informed in August if there is availability.

3. **Q Is there an age requirement to be put on the waiting list?**

A Yes. Children must be 3 by the end of August.

4. **Q What requirement must the under aged child meet?**

A All the following requirements must be met:

- a) the child must be toilet trained
- b) the child must no longer need naps
- c) the child must be able to handle our JK program.

Students will be assessed separately by the Kindergarten teacher, and by the principal to determine their academic, social, and emotional readiness. The final decision is at the discretion of the principal.
